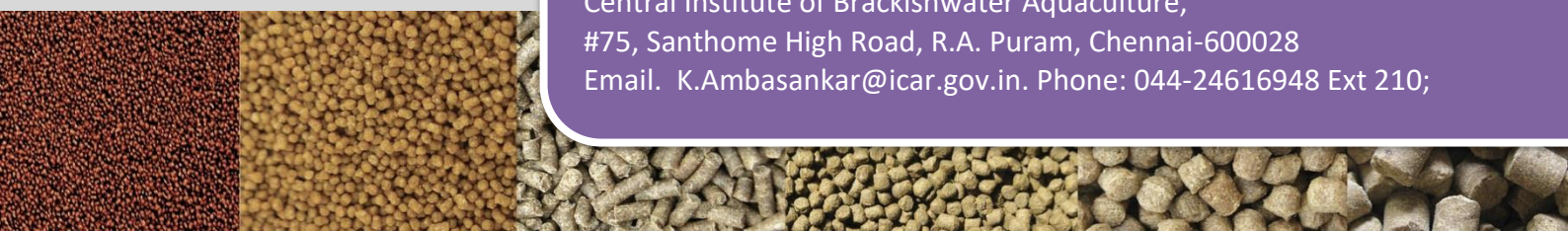

Travel

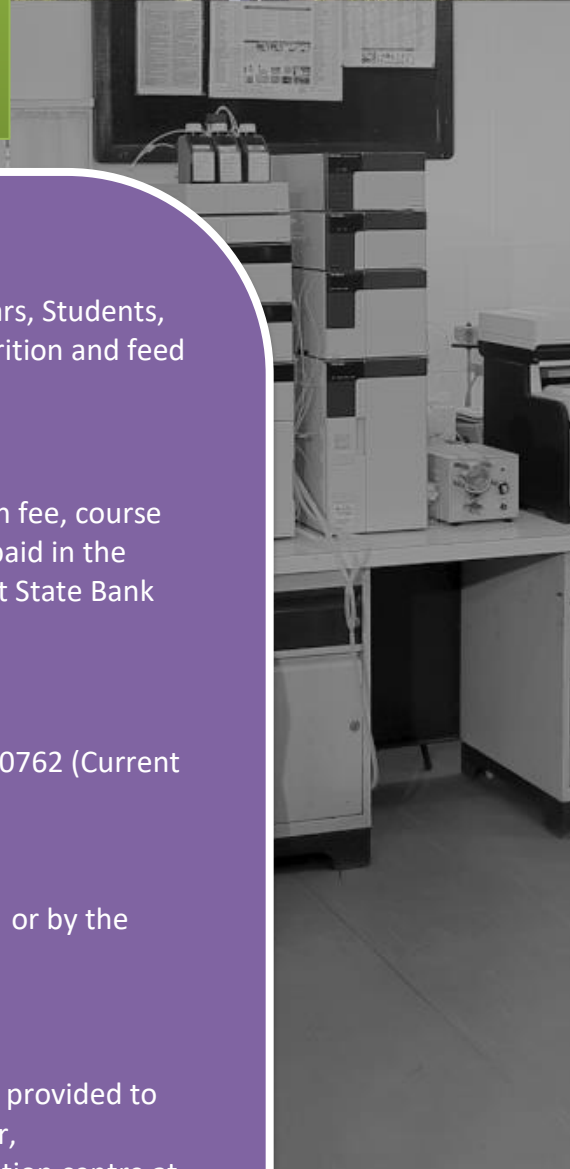
The expenditure on travel has to be borne by the sponsoring authority or by the candidates themselves.
